Test Prep/Practice Exams

1. Go to DOD MWR Libraries- <https://www.dodmwrlibraries.org/> (can be accessed on personal computers)
2. Enter DOD ID number and date of birth
3. Go to Continuing Education Icon
4. Select Access button on EBSCO LearningExpress
5. Go to Sign In/Register on EBSCO LearningExpress page and Register if new acct or Sign In
6. Once signed in, select Prepare for CLEP and DSST exams icon
7. Please note you may also download LearningExpress Mobile app if preferred

Registering/Scheduling CLEP/DSST Exams

On-Base National Test Center is administered by Columbia College, and they administer both CLEP and DSST exams. CLEP exams require pre-registration (process below), but DSST exams do not.

CLEP Pre-Registration Process

1. Go to - <https://clep.collegeboard.org/>
2. Register and log in
3. Go to "My CLEP Account" - "Manage My Profile" - and update required fields
4. Under "Personal Details" state - "Yes, I am eligible for DANTES Funding, Not a Veteran"
Note: For the purposes of registering for a CLEP exam, active duty military members are not veterans until they complete their active duty tour
5. Select applicable exam and add to cart (upon checkout the cart will show \$0 and state discounts as DANTES)
6. Complete checkout process and print ticket
7. Take CLEP ticket with you on test date
