Learning Modules

The Clearinghouse for Military Family Readiness at Penn State has developed over 100 online learning modules to help school personnel to increase understanding and awareness related to the unique challenges faced by military-connected students and families and to provide school personnel with strategies and resources to support military-connected students. Topics Include:

Supporting Military-Connected Students

Provides strategies to support military-connected students and families with their unique challenges.

Suicide Prevention

Provides strategies to prepare for, screen for, identify, and respond to suicidality in students.

Classroom Management

Provides strategies to promote positive student behavior and respond to student misbehavior.

Socioemotional Learning

Provides strategies to integrate SEL into academic content and provide SEL instruction.

Self-Care for School Personnel

Provides personal and professional self-care strategies for school personnel.

Engagement

Provides strategies to engage all students, including exceptional learners, and their families.



Vetted Resources

There are many high quality, free, evidence-informed resources that are available online. The Clearinghouse has identified, vetted, and selected resources to share with school personnel who work with military-connected students on a variety of topics based on utility, applicability, reputability of the developer, and level of evidence.
