COMMUNITY CONNECTIONS - PARTNERING FOR SUCCESS ublic Schools on Military Installations (PSMI)

- PSMIs are schools that are owned and operated by local education agencies (LEA), but are located on or surrounded by federal land
- 160 public schools are on military installations
- 40% are on DAF installations (64 schools)



- Advisor to the installation commander
- Consults and collaborates with installation agencies (e.g., CE, PHEO, SFS, OSI, JA, MDG, SE,
- Documents safety and security concerns, provides trend analysis and feedback to Command and District Administration
- Manages all inquiries, inspection visits, partnerships, volunteer opportunities, guest speakers, and collaboration between installation and PSMI
- Key player with Office of Local Defense and Community Cooperation PSMI Grant Program, including communication, site visits, meetings, and process navigation

A synergistic partnership is contingent on ensuring the SL is the linchpin between the command team, schools and all stakeholders





Holloman Air Force Base and Alamogordo Public Schools held a groundbreaking ceremony for the new \$59.6 million Holloman Elementary and Middle School project. Supported by the OLDCC PSMI Grant, this endeavor aims to develop cohesive outdoor areas for both school campuses and replace the existing middle school campus. 2 SLPMs were pivotal in ensuring this project remained a primary focus throughout the tenure of 4 installation commanders, 4 deputy commanders and 5 LEA superintendents.

Working Groups and Advisory Councils

Establishing working groups or councils between the military and K-12 education entities is crucial for driving meaningful change and fostering strong relationships in the communities we service. These collaborative bodies provide a structured platform for sharing insights and resources, aligning goals, and addressing common challenges, such as supporting military-connected students and integrating opportunities back into the community. By working together, the military and educators can create programs that benefit students, enhance understanding, and ensure that effectively support each other's missions, ultimately leading to stronger, more resilient communities.

- Develop programs for military families' unique needs
- Promote STEM education aligned with military skills
- Share resources and coordinate access
- Organize guest lectures and joint STEM projects
- Provide joint training on crisis management
- Integrate military mental health professionals into school support
- Strengthen partnerships among schools, command teams, and families to support student success and well-being.

MacDill Council for Education Excellence

Chaired by Wing Commander, installation and district leadership signed the MacDill AFB Education Strategy, formalizing the council and establishing shared objectives. The results? Modifying the district's school choice policy to accommodate military-connected students better, extending application and acceptance to the International Baccalaureate program for transferring students, establishing an expedited review process for new students with Individual Education Programs, accepting gifted designation from other states to ensure continuity of education, and revising the grade point average policy to avoid penalizing military-connected students. This year, through this partnership and having intentional conversations while redistricting the attendance zone, AD members were exempt and allowed to stay in the current school to reduce transitional barriers. Crisis Response and Emergency Contingency Planning

Schools are vital havens of safety and education, yet they must also be prepared to protect students from various threats and hazards, including crime, violence, natural disasters, disease outbreaks, and accidents. Collaborating with local government and community partners is crucial in preparing for emergencies. The School Liaison

Program Manager is a key player in the crisis action plan, as proven in 2022 with Robb Elementary School in Uvalde and in 2018 Hurricane Michael response with Task Force HARP. When COVID shut down communities, school liaisons continued to work to provide input into HPCON changes, online education efforts and initiatives, back-to-school plans, and state recovery efforts. Command Teams and School Liaisons should prepare and have a working knowledge of expected roles and responsibilities in school crisis response plans.



Know the number of military-connected students in each school

 Develop a comprehensive action plan, identify key personnel, and establish clear protocols for collaboration

Maintain open communication channels between the SLPM and Command Team

 Practice and review the Crisis Action Plan (CAP) or Integrated Defense Plan (IDP) with your Public Schools on Military Installations (PSMI)


 Review and revise existing agreements with schools in the local community outside the base.

• Ensure active engagement of your School Liaison with all stakeholders, providing the necessary support to navigate crisis situations successfully.

SLs should coordinate and integrate with schools serving military or federally connected students, aligning with Presidential Policy Directive (PPD-8) five mission areas: Prevention, Protection, Mitigation, Response, and Recovery.

Reporting Process - OSD Mandated

- Each Installation SLPM is responsible to:
 - Collaborate and coordinate with local/state education stakeholders, and other installations in their state
 - Provide education challenges, trends, best practices, and legislation/policy for their installation to the following:
 - State or DoDEA Regional
 - HQ SLP Division
 - Installation Commanders
 - Local Education Stakeholders
- Each DAF State Lead is responsible for:
 - Requesting and collecting <u>state</u> education challenges, trends, best practices and legislation/ policy
 - Prepare state slide and brief at SOE
 - Brief key stakeholders on the state status of education
