Registering/Scheduling CLEP/DSST Exams

On-Base National Test Center (fully DANTEs funded) is administered by Black Hills State University, and they administer both CLEP and DSST exams. CLEP exams require pre-registration (process below), but DSST exams do not.

CLEP Pre-Registration Process

1. Go to - <https://clep.collegeboard.org/>

2. Register and log in

3. Go to "My CLEP Account" - "Manage My Profile" - and update required fields

4. Under "Personal Details" state - "Yes, I am eligible for DANTEs Funding, Not a Veteran"

Note: For the purposes of registering for a CLEP exam, active duty military members are not veterans until they complete their active duty tour

5. **Do Not** have school identified as Community College of the Air Force (all score reports for DANTEs funded exams are auto sent to CCAF, identifying CCAF in the registration then causes a duplicate report)

6. Select applicable exam and add to cart (upon checkout the cart will show \$0 and state discounts as DANTEs)
